I am writing in response to the letter filed by School Energy Coalition (SEC) dated May 26, 2014 regarding the reprioritization of the following issues from secondary to primary: 4.6, 4.8, 5.2, 6.13, 7.2, 8.1, 8.2, 9.7, 9.9. For the reasons noted by SEC, AMPCO agrees with SEC that the need for oral evidence on the issues identified has become clearer through the review and dialogue leading up to and during the Settlement Conference and as a result, the issues should be reprioritized.

In particular, AMPCO notes that information from OPG's 2013 Annual Report regarding OPG's nuclear segregated funds and OPG's overfunded position in 2012 and 2013 (\$1.7 billion) was identified during preparation for the Settlement Conference and the treatment of these funds under the Ontario Nuclear Funding Agreement is unclear. AMPCO wishes to seek further clarity from OPG on any prescribed treatment of these earnings at the oral hearing.

The issues SEC seeks to reprioritize are material and may have an impact on payment amounts. AMPCO elieves the Board would benefit from further discovery on these issues.
