**Re: EB-2014-0002 – Horizon Utilities Corporation – Rates Application 2015-2019**

I am a consultant to the Consumers Council of Canada (“Council”). I have been instructed by my client to intervene in the Application of Horizon Utilities Corporation (“Horizon”) for approval of rates effective January 1, 2015.

The Council is a public interest entity which represents the interests of residential consumers of electricity and natural gas in Ontario. The outcome of this proceeding will ultimately impact the rates that Horizon’s residential customers will pay for electricity distribution service.

The Council intends to ask for an order of costs in this proceeding. The Council has participated in many of the Ontario Energy Board’s electricity distribution rate applications and policy consultation processes over a long period of time.
