**Re: wpd White Pines Wind Incorporated – Procedural Order No. 2
EB-2013-0339**

We are legal counsel to wpd White Pines Wind Incorporated (“wpd”) in respect of the above noted application for leave to construct transmission facilities (the “**Application**”) and we write in response to Procedural Order No. 2 and the evidence filed by the County of Prince Edward, the Alliance to Protect Prince Edward County (“**APPEC**”) and AL S. Warunkiw (collectively, the “**Intervenors**”) pursuant to same.

We note that Gordon Gibbons did not file any evidence in his personal capacity as an intervenor despite expressing an intention to do so. While Mr. Gibbons has provided an affidavit in his capacity as the Chair of APPEC, it is not clear to wpd if, or to what extent, Mr. Gibbons himself relies on evidence filed by APPEC. wpd requests that Mr. Gibbons provide the evidence that he indicated he would file in this proceeding or, alternatively, that Mr. Gibbons advise the Board if he relies on the evidence filed by APPEC and if so, to what extent.

wpd has no interrogatories in respect of the evidence filed by the Intervenors. As such, the June 23, 2014 deadline set by the Board for filing responses to interrogatories will not be required. wpd therefore requests that the Board issue a new procedural order setting dates for the remaining steps in the Application.


