Page 3, section 7. of Reference (1) states as follows:

- 7. *The Applicant has not provided or offered to the County, as an owner of land affected by the Applicant's proposed route, any form of agreement, including any "road use agreement" as referenced in the Applicant's response to our Interrogatory. Nor have there been any meaningful discussions to date to suggest what the terms of such an agreement might contain.*

In response to Board staff interrogatory 4 regarding the status of any negotiations/approvals/agreements with the County of Prince Edward (the County" with respect to the placement of the transmission line underground on municipal road allowances, the Applicant responded as follows:

There have been no further discussions with the township of Prince Edward County since March 15, 2013. wpd's recent attempts to initiate further discussions in November and December 2013 were unsuccessful.

Questions / Requests

- (a) Please explain why discussions between the Applicant and the County regarding the placement of the transmission line on municipal road allowances have not taken place since March 2013.
- (b) Did the Applicant attempt to initiate further discussions with the County in November and December 2013? If so, what was the outcome and why was it unsuccessful?
