RE: EB-2014-0154 – London Property Management Association Support for TransAlta Motion

Union Gas ("Union") filed an application dated April 3, 2014 with the Ontario Energy Board ("Board") for an order approving a one-time exemption from its approved rate schedules to reduce certain penalty charges applied to direct purchase customers who did not meet their contractual obligations during the months of February and March, 2014.

The Board issued Procedural Order No. 1 on May 27, 2014 that provided for the filing of interrogatories, among other things.

On June 20, 2014, TransAlta Corporation ("TransAlta") filed a motion with the Board seeking an order requiring Union to provide full and adequate responses to certain interrogatories that Union did not provide responses to as Union indicated the questions were not relevant to their request to lower the penalty charges.

The London Property Management Association ("LPMA") has reviewed the Written Submissions and materials in support of the TransAlta motion and supports those submissions.

In particular, LPMA submits that responses to the Subject Interrogatories, as defined in the TransAlta written submission are necessary for the Board and parties to determine the level of impacts on individual customers, be they direct purchase customers that incurred the penalties which are the subject of this proceeding, direct purchase customers that did not incur any penalties, and system gas customers that also incurred higher than normal costs because of the weather experienced in the winter of 2013/2014.

Without the above noted information, LPMA submits that the Board and parties may be unable to determine if Union's proposal to reduce the penalties is appropriate, insufficient or not required.
