INTERIM DECISION AND ORDER
July 10, 2014

Suncor Adelaide Wind Limited Partnership filed an application on July 2, 2014 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 (the “Act”) for an electricity generator licence as a Feed-In Tariff Program participant.

As prescribed under section 57 of the Act, all entities generating electricity in the Ontario electricity market are required to hold a licence. With its application, the applicant filed a letter requesting an interim licence to facilitate the Independent Electricity System Operator’s connection requirements and compliance with market rules.

Considering the time required to process the application in accordance with the Board’s established practice and procedures, and considering the applicant’s need for a licence to carry out activities as an electricity generator, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue an interim order under sections 21(4)(b) and 21(7) of the Act granting the requested electricity generator licence, pending the final disposition of the matter. The applicant is reminded that this interim decision does not constitute a final decision on the application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

An electricity generation licence is granted, on an interim basis, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence. The licence will be valid until October 9, 2014 or until the final determination of the electricity generation licence application, whichever is earlier.
