# NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING UNION GAS LIMITED GAS FRANCHISE APPROVAL FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF BRUCE MINES

Union Gas Limited ("Union" or the "Applicant") has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") dated October 19, 2006 under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended, for an order of the Board approving the terms and conditions upon which and the period for which the Corporation of the Town of Bruce Mines is, by by-law, to grant to the applicant the right to construct and operate works for the distribution, transmission and storage of natural gas and the right to extend and add to the works in the Town of Bruce Mines (the "Municipality"). The applicant has also applied for an order of the Board declaring and directing that the assent of the electors of the Municipality to the by-law is not necessary. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2006-0264.

The applicant has a Franchise Agreement with the Municipality effective October 5, 1987, which expires on October 5, 2007. Union also holds a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, for the Municipality, granting it the right to construct works to supply natural gas.

### How to See Union's Pre-filed Evidence

Copies of the application and pre-filed evidence in support of Union's application will be available for inspection for public inspection at the Board's offices, the applicant's offices, and at the office of the Municipality (addresses below).

## **How to Participate**

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

1. You may send the Board a letter of comment. Your letter should include any

- request to make an oral presentation to the Board, and must be received by the Board no later than 30 days from the publication date of this notice.
- 2. You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter received by the Board no later than 10 days from the publication date of this notice.
- 3. You may request intervenor status if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter of intervention received no later than 10 days from the publication date of this notice, or, if you have been served this notice personally, no later than 10 days from the date of service. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the proceeding; and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.
