**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING
ENBRIDGE GAS DISTRIBUTION INCORPORATED
GAS FRANCHISE AND CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY APPROVAL FOR THE
CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITEWATER REGION**

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. (“Enbridge” or the “Applicant”) has filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) dated September 18, 2006 under section 9 of the *Municipal Franchises Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.55, as amended, for an order of the Board approving the terms and conditions upon which and the period for which the Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region (the “Township” or the “Municipality”) is, by by-law, to grant to the applicant the right to construct and operate works for the distribution, transmission and storage of natural gas and the right to extend and add to the works in the Municipality. The applicant has also applied for an order of the Board declaring and directing that the assent of the electors of the Municipality to the by-law is not necessary. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2006-0229.

Enbridge has also applied for an order of the Board approving a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”) for the entire Municipality. The Board has assigned File No. EB-2006-0230 to this application.

On January 1, 2001 the Village of Cobden, Township of Ross, the Township of Westmeath and the Village of Beachburg were amalgamated to form the Township of Whitewater Region. Enbridge holds franchise agreements and Certificates for all of the former municipalities with the exception of the former Village of Beachburg. This application, if approved, would expand Enbridge’s distribution service territory to include the former Village of Beachburg.

How to See Enbridge's Pre-filed Evidence

Copies of the application and pre-filed evidence in support of Enbridge's application will be available for inspection for public inspection at the Board's offices, the applicant's offices, and at the office of the Municipality (addresses below).

How to Participate

You may participate in this proceeding in one of three ways:

1. You may send the Board a letter of comment. Your letter should include any request to make an oral presentation to the Board, and must be received by the Board no later than 10 days from the publication date of this notice.
2. You may request observer status in order to receive documents issued by the Board in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter received by the Board no later than 5 days from the publication date of this notice.
3. You may request intervenor status if you wish to actively participate in the proceeding. Your request must be made by letter of intervention received no later than 5 days from the publication date of this notice, or, if you have been served this notice personally, no later than 5 days from the date of service. Your letter of intervention must include a description of how you are, or may be, affected by the proceeding and if you represent a group, a description of the group and its membership. The Board may choose to hold either a written or an oral hearing. Your letter of intervention should indicate your preference for a written or oral hearing, and the reasons for that preference. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. You must indicate in your letter of intervention whether you expect to seek costs from the applicant and the grounds for your eligibility for costs. You must provide a copy of your letter of intervention to the applicant.
