Relevant experience:

- Edith is a member of Enbridge Gas Distribution's regulatory team. She manages upstream and major projects, including facilities applications at the Board. Most recently, she has been working with EGD Asset Management and DSM groups in evaluating integrated solutions to facilities planning. Earlier on at EGD, she played a key role in developing gas services for generators. She continues to manage gas-electricity interface issues.
- Edith has been providing part-time regulatory assistance to NextBridge (also known as Upper Canada Transmission), the designated developer of the East-West Tie transmission facilities. She has gained knowledge in electricity transmission and liaises with the OPA on transmission requirements for northwest Ontario.
- Edith is a member of the IESO's Technical Panel. She has served as a Technical Panel member for more than five years and is familiar with many aspects of Ontario's electricity market rules and system operation issues.
- Prior to EGD, Edith worked for various manufacturers in diversified roles such as energy management, marketing, process engineering and quality assurance. While at energy management, she represented her employer at AMPCO and IGUA, and has watched the electricity and gas industries in and outside Ontario from different perspectives.

The gas distribution community will be Edith's main constituency. However, Edith will also bring perspectives of a system operator, a transmitter, a distributor, a service provider and an industrial user. She will contribute to the understanding of the technical and process challenges of regional planning and help identify integrated solutions which align with the public good.
