PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1
August 13, 2014

Wyse Meter Solutions Inc. filed a complete application on July 4, 2014 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* for renewal of its unit sub-metering licence. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2014-0214.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Written Hearing (the "Notice") dated July 18, 2014. On August 8, 2014, Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited ("THESL") filed a request for intervenor status.

The Notice stated that if a party wishes to participate in the written hearing, the party may file a written submission setting out its views on the application. Submissions were to be filed by August 8, 2014. The Notice did not include instructions for parties wishing to request intervenor status. Therefore, I will not grant THESL intervenor status.

I will however extend the deadline for THESL to file a written submission, if THESL chooses to do so, and find it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. THESL may file a submission setting out its views on the application by August 20, 2014. The submission should be filed with the Board and copied to the applicant.
2. The applicant may file a reply submission by August 27, 2014. The submission should be filed with the Board and copied to THESL.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2014-0214, be made through the Board's web portal at <https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
