AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Halton Hills Hydro Inc. for an order, approving the recovery of amounts related to the restoration of electricity service in the Town of Halton Hills due to the December 2013 Southern and Eastern Ontario Ice Storm, to be effective November 1, 2014 for 24 months.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 2 September 9, 2014

Halton Hills Hydro Inc. ("Halton Hills Hydro") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on June 6, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for the recovery of certain amounts related to the restoration of electricity service in the Town of Halton Hills due to an ice storm in December 2013.

The Board issued Procedural Order No. 1 on July 22, 2014, which established dates for interrogatories to the applicant and for Halton Hills Hydro's responses to the interrogatories. Halton Hills Hydro filed its responses to interrogatories with the Board on September 2, 2014.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

 Board staff and intervenors wishing to file a written submission shall do so by September 23, 2014. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Halton Hills Hydro and intervenors. 2. Halton Hills Hydro may file a written reply submission with the Board, and deliver it to intervenors by **October 7, 2014**.
