Networks Inc., for an Order or Orders granting Leave to
construct Transmission Facilities in the City of Brampton.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1

Hydro One Networks Inc. (the "Applicant") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the "Board") dated September 29, 2006 under section 92 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15, Schedule B. The Applicant has applied for an order of the Board for leave to construct approximately 4.2 kilometres of 230 Kilovolt electricity transmission line. The Applicant also proposes to install four in-line circuit breakers at a new switching station ("SS") to be called Hurontario SS. The proposed facilities will be installed in the City of Brampton at an estimated cost of approximately \$42 million.

The proposed facilities are located on land designated for utility use, entirely on the Parkway Belt. The facilities do not require the acquisition of any additional land or land rights. The Board assigned File No. EB-2006-0215 to this application and issued a Notice of Application dated October 16, 2006.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters. Please be aware that further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Intervenor and Board Staff who wish information and material from the Applicant that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board, and delivered to the Applicant on or before Thursday, November 30, 2006.

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2. The Applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the Intervenor no later than Thursday, December 7, 2006.
3. **All filings with the Board noted in the Order must be in the form of 10 hard copies and received by the Board by 5:00 p.m. on the stated date.** The Board requires all correspondence to be in electronic form as well as paper. Therefore, all parties must also e-mail an electronic copy of their filings in accessible, searchable PDF format to the Board Secretary at Boardsec@oeb.gov.on.ca. Parties must also include the Case Manager, Michael Bell michael.bell@oeb.gov.on.ca and Board Counsel, Donna Campbell donna.campbell@oeb.gov.on.ca on all electronic correspondence related to this case.
