AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective January 1, 2015.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 September 23, 2014

Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Limited ("Innisfil Hydro") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 13, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) and under the Board's Filing Requirements for Incentive Regulation Rate Applications. Innisfil Hydro is seeking approval for changes to the rates that Innisfil Hydro charges for electricity distribution, to be effective January 1, 2015. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2014-0086.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on September 2, 2014. Energy Probe Research Foundation ("Energy Probe"), Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") and School Energy Coalition ("SEC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility in relation to Innisfil Hydro's request for incremental capital due to the construction of new corporate headquarters and the approval of a new deferral account to track the impact of conservation programs by the Town of Innisfil. No objection was received.

I have determined that Energy Probe, VECC and SEC are granted intervenor status and that Energy Probe, VECC and SEC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* in relation to Innisfil Hydro's request outlined above.

The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this Procedural Order.

I consider it necessary to make provision for written interrogatories and interrogatory responses. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff, Energy Probe, VECC and SEC shall request any information and material from Innisfil Hydro that is in addition to Innsifil's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served on Innisfil Hydro on or before **October 3, 2014**.
- 2. Innisfil Hydro shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on Energy Probe, VECC and SEC on or before **October 16, 2014.**

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2014-0086 and be made electronically through the Board's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/ in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Two paper copies must also be filed at the Board's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
