AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Canadian Niagara Power Inc. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective January 1, 2015.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 September 24, 2014

Canadian Niagara Power Inc. ("CNPI") filed a complete application (the "Application") with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on August 15, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B) and under the Board's Filing Requirements for Incentive Regulation Rate Applications. CNPI is seeking approval for changes to the rates that CNPI charges for electricity distribution, to be effective January 1, 2015. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2014-0061.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on September 4, 2014. The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility in relation to CNPI's request for disposition of the balance in its variance account caused by the difference between the actual revenue impacts of conservation programs relative to what was anticipated. No objection was received.

I approve VECC as an intervenor and that VECC is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* in relation CNPI's request outlined above.

The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this procedural order.

Parties are reminded to consult sections 26 and 27 of the Board's *Rules of Practice and Procedure* (as revised April 24, 2014) regarding required naming and numbering conventions and other matters related to interrogatories.

I consider it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. Provision is being made for written submissions following the filing of interrogatory responses, unless the Board orders otherwise during the course of the proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff and VECC shall request any information and material from CNPI that is in addition to CNPI's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served on CNPI on or before **September 30, 2014**.
- 2. CNPI shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them on VECC on or before **October 6, 2014.**
- 3. Unless the Board orders otherwise, Board staff and VECC wishing to file a written submission shall do so by **October 20, 2014**. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to CNPI and VECC.
- 4. Unless the Board orders otherwise, CNPI may file a written reply submission with the Board, and deliver it to VECC by **November 3, 2014**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2014-0061 and be made electronically through the Board's web portal at

Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at <u>http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry</u>. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
