AFFIDAVIT OF GREG TOWSTEGO

I, Greg Towstego, of the Town of Richmond Hill, in the Province of Ontario, Senior Manager, Ontario Power Generation Inc.,

MAKE OATH AND SAY:

1. In my capacity as Senior Manager, Ontario Regulatory Affairs with Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG"), I was responsible for arranging for publication of the Notice of Application and Written Hearing (the "Notice") in the matter of EB-2014-0194, pursuant to the Ontario Energy Board's Letter of Direction dated July 28, 2014.
2. I instructed the Corporate Relations and Communications department of OPG to arrange for the publication of the English version of the Notice, together with the map (true copies of which are attached as **Exhibit A**) and/or the French version of the Notice, together with the map (true copies of which are attached as **Exhibit B**), as appropriate, in the English and French language periodicals specified by the Ontario Energy Board in its Letter of Direction and as listed in **Exhibit C** of this affidavit.

3. I am advised by Ms. Kathryn Peck, Communication Services Manager, Corporate Relations and Communications department of OPG, that OPG engaged the firm of kbs+ to arrange for publication of the English version of the Notice and the French version of the Notice in the respective English language, French language, and English/French language publications. OPG forwarded copies of the English and French language versions of the Notice to kbs+ electronically.

4. I am further advised by Ms. Peck that she was advised by kbs+ that Kapuskasing L'Horizon no longer publishes in any form, whether paper or digital. However, Ms. Peck was informed that the Kapuskasing Weekender has a bonus arrangement with the Kapuskasing Northern Times, such that when OPG books a French insertion in the Kapuskasing Weekender, OPG can obtain a bonus French insertion in the Kapuskasing Northern Times. As the Letter of Direction required OPG to place a French publication of the Notice in the Kapuskasing Weekender, OPG was able to avail itself of the bonus deal and also place a French insertion of the Notice in the Kapuskasing Northern Times. Prior to finalization of OPG's media plan for the publications, I requested, via email, the approval of Ontario Energy Board staff of this alternate arrangement, whereby the bonus French insertion in the Kapuskasing Northern Times would essentially replace the foregone insertion in Kapuskasing L'Horizon and reach the same audience. By reply email, Ontario Energy Board staff indicated their approval of this arrangement (a copy of which email is attached as **Exhibit D**), and OPG directed kbs+ to book an insertion of the French version of the Notice in the Kapuskasing Northern Times.

5. Attached as **Exhibit E** is a copy of the insertion order, obtained from kbs+, for publication of the Notice in those periodicals listed in Exhibit D. To the best of my knowledge, the respective Notices were published on the dates, in the language and in the periodicals as set out in **Exhibit E**.
6. On Wednesday, August 6, 2014, I arranged for service of a copy of the English version and the French version of the Notice (true copies of which are attached as **Exhibit F**), together with a copy of the Application, to be made by courier or by registered mail (Express Post), on the persons/entities set out in the distribution list which is attached and marked as **Exhibit G**. Attached as **Exhibit H** is a true copy of the courier and Express Post receipts with respect to the service to the recipients.

As directed in paragraph 8 of the Letter of Direction, affected municipalities received service of a copy of the English version and the French version of the Notice, together with a copy of the Application and the pre-filed evidence. The affected municipalities are as follows, and are included in the distribution list and copy of courier receipts provided in Exhibits G and H, respectively, referred to above:

- (i.) The Corporation of the Town of Cochrane
- (ii.) The Corporation of the Town of Smooth Rock Falls
- (iii.) The Corporation of the Town of Kapuskasing



Ontario Power Generation Inc. is asking the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for permission to construct approximately 7 kilometres of 115 kilovolt electricity transmission line and associated facilities on behalf of Ontario Power Generation Inc. and Coral Rapids Power Limited Partnership. The transmission line would connect a proposed 25 megawatt New Post Creek Hydroelectric Project to an existing Hydro One transmission line west of the Abitibi River.

Ontario Power Generation Inc. has indicated that the proposed transmission line will be located entirely on Crown land. Ontario Power Generation Inc. says it will work with the Ministry of Natural Resources to develop an easement agreement with the Crown.

A map of the proposed route for the transmission line is printed below.

Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s application to the OEB concerns construction of the proposed transmission line only. It does not concern the construction or operation of the New Post Creek Hydroelectric Project itself.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. It will hold a public hearing to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s request. During this hearing, the OEB will consider evidence and arguments by Ontario Power Generation Inc. and by individuals, municipalities and others whose interests would be affected.

The OEB hearing will consider specific issues required by law.

The *Ontario Energy Board Act* specifies the issues the OEB is to consider in making its decision. If you wish to participate in the OEB hearing, it is important for you to understand what these issues are.

As required by the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, the OEB will consider three issues:

- The interests of consumers with respect to prices and the reliability and quality of electricity service;
- In a manner consistent with the policies of the Government of Ontario, the promotion of the use of renewable energy sources; and
- The form of agreement that Ontario Power Generation Inc. offers to landowners affected by the route or location of the transmission line.

The OEB hearing is not the only approval process required before a line is built. For example, most transmission lines are subject to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change's environmental assessment process. The Board's review will only address the three factors outlined above and will not address other factors, such as environmental, health, aesthetics or property value impacts.

You have the right to information regarding Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s application. You can read Ontario Power Generation's Inc.'s application on the OEB's website (see below under "LEARN MORE").



- Send the OEB a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing; or
- Ask the OEB for permission to be an active participant in the hearing (an intervenor). To be an intervenor, a party must be affected by the transmission line in a way that relates directly to the issues the OEB will consider. If you wish to be an intervenor, the OEB must receive your request by August 25, 2014.

Ontario Power Generation Inc. is asking the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for permission to construct approximately 7 kilometers of 115 kilovolt electricity transmission line and associated facilities on behalf of Ontario Power Generation Inc. and Coral Rapids Power Limited Partnership. The transmission line would connect a proposed 25 megawatt New Post Creek Hydroelectric Project to an existing Hydro One transmission line west of the Abitibi River.

Ontario Power Generation Inc. has indicated that the proposed transmission line will be located entirely on Crown land. Ontario Power Generation Inc. says it will work with the Ministry of Natural Resources to develop an easement agreement with the Crown.

A map of the proposed route for the transmission line is printed below.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. It will hold a public hearing to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s request. The OEB hearing will consider specific issues required by law.
