Distribution Inc. for an Order pursuant to Section 90(1) of the
Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, granting leave to construct a
natural gas pipeline and related facilities in the City of Brampton.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board"), dated January 30, 2006, under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). Enbridge has applied for an order of the Board granting leave to construct approximately 6.5 kilometres of 24 inch diameter steel natural gas pipeline (the "pipeline") in the City of Brampton.

The proposed route of the pipeline will originate from the TransCanada Pipeline Ltd. pipeline on the south side of Sandalwood Parkway just west of Mountainash Road and proceed east along the south side of Sandalwood Parkway for approximately 1,000 metres to Airport Road. At Airport Road, the pipeline will proceed southeast along the south side of constructed and unconstructed sections of Humberwest Parkway for approximately 1,087 metres and cross Castlemore Road. The pipeline will proceed along the southwest side of the proposed Humberwest Parkway for approximately 1,718 metres and cross Williams Parkway. At Williams Parkway, the pipeline will proceed along Humberwest Parkway for approximately 1,542 metres and cross Queen Street East. The pipeline will then proceed along the west side of Goreway Drive and along the Goreway Electricity Generating Station ("Goreway Station") property boundary for approximately 1,170 metres to a point of interconnection with the Goreway Station.

The Board has assigned the application File No. EB-2005-0539. The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on February 14, 2006. The Notice of Application and Hearing was published and served by Enbridge as directed by the Board.

The Board has decided to proceed by way of a written hearing. This Procedural Order allows for further interrogatories on Enbridge's responses to initial interrogatories and sets the dates for submissions from the parties. The dates set for intervenor evidence, interrogatories and responses on that evidence were established in Procedural Order Number 1 and remain unchanged. The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters. Please be aware that further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Intervenors and Board staff who wish further clarification from Enbridge on initial interrogatories, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to Enbridge and the Intervenors on or before Friday, May 5, 2006.
2. Enbridge shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the Intervenors no later than Monday, May 15, 2006.
3. Intervenors and Board Staff shall file written submissions, if any, with the Board and deliver them to Enbridge and the Intervenors on or before Friday June 2, 2006.
4. Enbridge shall file a written reply submission with the Board and deliver it to Intervenors on or before Wednesday, June 14, 2006.
5. All filings with the Board noted in the Order must be in the form of 9 hard copies and received by the Board by 4:30 p.m. on the stated date. The Board requires all correspondence to be in electronic form as well as in hard copy. In addition to the hard copy, all parties must e-mail an electronic copy of their filings in searchable PDF format to the Board Secretary at boardsec@oeb.gov.on.ca
