IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Veridian Connections Inc. for an order approving the recovery of certain amounts related to the restoration of electricity service in the service areas of Ajax, Pickering, Clarington and Port Hope due to an ice storm in December 2013, to be effective May 1, 2015 for 24 months.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 1 October 7, 2014

Veridian Connections Inc. ("Veridian") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on August 22, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for the recovery of certain amounts related to the restoration of electricity service in the service areas of Ajax, Pickering, Clarington and Port Hope due to an ice storm in December 2013. The Board has assigned File Number EB-2014-0272 to this application.

A Notice of Application and Hearing was issued on September 10, 2014. Energy Probe Research Foundation ("Energy Probe") and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility. No objection was received from Veridian.

I approve Energy Probe and VECC as intervenors. The list of parties in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this Procedural Order. I have also determined that the intervenors are each eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

Consistent with the considerations outlined in the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*, section 5, intervenors are reminded to adopt a focused approach to the

discrete issue before the Board in this application, given the limited scope of this proceeding.

Veridian has requested a written hearing in this case. Any party that believes an oral hearing is required may make a submission to the Board setting out the reasons why in writing.

I consider it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Board staff and intervenors shall request any information and material from Veridian that is in addition to Veridian's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and served to Veridian on or before **October 16, 2014**.
- 2. Veridian shall file with the Board complete written responses to the interrogatories and serve them to the intervenors on or before **October 30, 2014.**
- 3. Unless the Board orders otherwise, Board staff, Energy Probe and VECC wishing to file a written submission shall do so by **November 14, 2014**. Any submission should be filed with the Board and delivered to Veridian, Energy Probe and VECC.
- Unless the Board orders otherwise, Veridian may file a written reply submission with the Board, and deliver it to Energy Probe and VECC by November 28, 2014.

If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.
