

## U-boat, freighter found off N. Carolina

LONDON, ENGLAND — The wrecks of a German U-boat and American freighter sunk during the Battle of the Atlantic have been found 50 kilometers off the coast of North Carolina.

The dive team of 3-76 and Bluefields, the dive unit of the Royal Navy's Underwater Archaeology Branch, were able to identify the wrecks after five years of research on the seabed at a depth of 100 meters. A British diver, David Lutjens, was part of the team that discovered the wrecks.



## Mormons open up about often ridiculed undergarments

SALT LAKE CITY — The Mormon church is addressing the mystery garments worn by its faithful with an in-depth, while edifying, explanation of the practice it considers a symbol of Latter-day Saints' devotion to God.

The four-minute video on The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints' website compares the white, two-piece cotton temple garments to today's athletic wear, such as a Catholic nun habit or Buddhist skullcap.

The video comes two years after the church website in the past two years have addressed the faith's past ban on black men in the lay clergy. It's early history of polygamy, and the misconception that members cast together to get their own place in the afterlife. The latest video dispels those notions that Latter-day Saints believe in temporal powers, a stereotype perpetuated on the internet and in popular culture by the church's leader, the sacred clothing as "magical."

"They do not understand their significance," says Eric Hawkins, a spokesman for the church. The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a fair, stable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process. You can review Hydro One's application and the Settlement Agreement on the OEB's website now.
