AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Great Lakes Power Transmission Inc. on behalf of Great Lakes Power Transmission LP seeking changes to its electricity transmission revenue requirement for 2015 and 2016 to be effective January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 4

November 17, 2014

Great Lakes Power Transmission Inc. on behalf of Great Lakes Power Transmission LP ("GLPT") filed a complete cost of service application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on July 14, 2014 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to its electricity transmission revenue requirements for 2015 and 2016 to be effective January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016.

Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 1, a Settlement Conference was held on October 28, 2014. On November 12, 2014 GLPT filed a Settlement Proposal on behalf of the parties to the settlement, being GLPT, Energy Probe Research Foundation, the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition and the School Energy Coalition. Two intervenors, the Independent Electricity System Operator and Upper Canada Transmission Inc., did not participate in the Settlement Conference nor are they parties to the settlement. The Settlement Proposal indicates a complete settlement on all the issues. Board staff filed a submission on the Settlement Proposal on November 13, 2014.

The Board will hold a hearing on the Settlement Proposal on November 19, 2014. The hearing will be limited to the matter raised in the Board staff submission concerning subaccount IFRS Gains and Losses within deferral account 1508.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

 An oral hearing shall be convened on **November 19, 2014** starting at 10:30 a.m. and concluding by noon in the Board's hearing room on the 25th Floor at 2300 Yonge Street, Toronto.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, **EB-2014-0238**, be made electronically through the Board's web portal at

If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below.
