Dear Sirs:

I am a resident of Amherst Island and am greatly concerned about the proposal to construct a new underwater electricity transmission cable to Amherst Island.

That cable if built, is intended to lead to the proposed construction of 33- 37, 50-storey tall wind turbines on Amherst Island, a serious, costly and permanent consequence which a large majority of Amherst island residents, island visitors, Nature and Heritage organizations do not want. Regarding the method by which the OEB will seek public comment on the proposed cable, I request that Island comment be obtained by oral hearing on Amherst Island.

Further, we understand that Windlectric now proposes to construct on the Island, steel poles up to 80 feet in height. This modification is not reflected in the updated Construction Plan Report, has not been divulged to the people of Amherst Island who, as a result have not had the opportunity to comment on this unwelcome intrusion into Island life.

Further still, extensive economic analysis shows that the Windlectric/Algonquin project, if approved and built will yield a zero to negative return on investment. As such, would the OEB explain how the proposed underwater cable to the Island be economically justified.
