Our Comments, Suggestions, Questions and Concerns;

After several calls from Loomis Express, Union's Notice of Application arrived. It strikes us as rather odd that after some 40 years of correspondence with Union the Application was sent to a wrong address.

We contacted Mr. Murray for an explanation not only for the wrong address but also why, as indicated in Item # 44 on page 8, we were not consulted about any concerns. Mr. Murray indicated he would provide us with an answer by November 20th., 2014 but as of this writing there has been no response.

We would suggest the Pool sign be made larger with the 911 number included and visible at some distance. Suggest at least from 100 meters. This would greatly aid in any emergency response.

We have the following questions, one how often are the emergency shut off (isolating) valves tested? Is it documented and where?

and two; pipe and equipment is operated at a regulated safety factor. How is the maximum factor determined on the formation, or is it?

and three; should there be a catastrophic failure how are the landowners to be compensated for their monetary loss of a valuable resource and is there a process in place for reporting such a failure to the Board & the affected Landowners?

and four; since Union will no doubt profit from this increased storage capacity should not the Board increase Landowner compensation as a result?

Our main concern at the moment is we have an excellent quality fresh water well, which we would appreciate if it stayed that way.

However fractures in storage caverns are not unheard of. One occurred several years ago in Moore Township, so there are limits to pressurization that are a guess at the best of times.

Should any act occur that jeopardizes my fresh water supply is the Board prepared to maintain an adequate supply at no expense on our behalf?
