Industrial Gas Users Association (IGUA) Supplementary Comments.

Further to our letter of comment in the captioned matter dated December 15, 2014, we and Aegent have reviewed the interrogatory responses herein filed by EGD yesterday afternoon. IGUA appreciates EGD's responses.

EGD's responses include the advice that EGD is proposing changes in its 2015 gas supply plan that have impacted November and December 2014 gas purchases at Dawn (and thus the PGVA balances to be cleared in this application) [Ex.I/T2/S2].

IGUA will further consider its position on EGD's proposed 2015 gas supply plan at the appropriate time. As noted in our earlier correspondence herein, IGUA is satisfied that EGD has properly followed the QRAM methodology and takes no objection to the relief claimed by EGD in this application.
