I am responding to Windlectric's application for permission to construct 5.9 km of transmission line, including submarine cable and eleven 80 foot steel poles linking the transmission line across Front Road on Amherst Island to the west of the school to a hydro substation via buried cable to link the transmission line to a hydro substation on the mainland.

I am concerned about interrupting the power supply to Amherst Island, which is the victim of many outages already.

I am especially concerned about the damage that might be done to the groundwater systems on the Island.

Insofar as so much is going to done close to the school I am concerned for the safety of the school children.

I also believe that there will be dangers and inconveniences to the Little family on the second concession who will be surrounded by turbines, a hydro substation, a cement batching plant, a special maintenance building and the traffic of heavy equipment and vehicles. This is too much for one family to take.

I figure the majority of Amherst Island residents do not want the wind turbines because they will change this rural paradise into an industrial park with huge wind turbines overwhelming everything.

Amherst Island is a unique farming community which has attracted newcomers because it is a quiet, pastoral jewel in Lake Ontario. It is not the place to erect monstrous towers which will change the landscape and will power blades which will kill the birds for which Amherst Island is famous.
