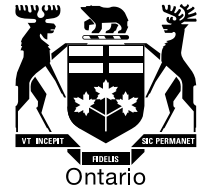

**Re: Suncor Energy Products Inc. ("Suncor")
Application for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities
Board File No. EB-2014-0022**

The Board has determined that further clarification pertaining to the location referenced in the CIA Addendum Report of June 8, 2012 (the "CIA Report") is necessary.

The Board notes intervenor WAIT-PW's argument that the Customer Impact Assessment (CIA) report is not valid because it references a different location. In WAIT-PW's correspondence to the Board dated September 2, 2014, at page 5, paragraph (c), it submitted that: "the Hydro One Networks Inc.'s (Hydro One) Customer Impact Assessment report is not valid for the Applicant's Proposed Transmission Facilities because it references a different location and the Applicant has not disputed that fact".

The Board further notes that at section 1.2.1 of the CIA Report, the report states that the Cedar Point Customer Generation Station (CGS) is located in the Municipality of Adelaide-Metcalf while the application states that the transformer station associated with the Cedar Point Project is located in the Township of Bosanquet in the Municipality of Lambton Shores.

The Board must be assured that the CIA Report is based on the project configuration that has been applied for by Suncor.

For that reason, the Board requires Suncor to respond to any discrepancy that WAIT-PW identifies in its response to the Board.

The Board also requests that Suncor clarify any discrepancy related to the location of the transmission facilities referenced in the CIA Report and the location referenced elsewhere in the pre-filed evidence.

Lastly, the Board requires Suncor to have Hydro One Networks Inc. acknowledge that the location of the CGS that is contained in its CIA Report is not the same as the location of the transformer station that is identified in the application, to explain the discrepancy, and to confirm that the CIA Report remains accurate.
