

Addendum to Review of Past OEB Cases

EB-2011-0013, 0014, 0015 Decision with Reasons Report dated July 19, 2011

Findings

“The Board is satisfied that Union holds the necessary P&NG and storage rights agreements for the private properties within the proposed DSA and that the compensation offer extended to Jacob Pool storage landowners will be comparable to Union’s standard payments to its other landowners in the Lambton County where most of the storage pools are located.”

Here the Board has chosen to broaden its principle of equitable treatment. The Board is satisfied that all landowners within the Jacob Pool receive the same compensation. However, the Board then goes a step further by noting that the compensation offer extended to the Jacob Pool storage landowners will be similar to what other landowners in other pools receive. It is no longer sufficient to just have compensation equality within a given pool, it is necessary that the compensation is comparable across the different pools.
