We have reviewed the interrogatory responses filed by EGD. In response to Procedural Order No. 2, VECC is not seeking a Technical Conference. As we are still analysing the responses we believe the suggestion of Board Staff to allow parties to put in writing any further requests for clarification of matters would be helpful.
