AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Suncor Energy Products Inc. to determine the location of electricity distribution facilities within road allowances owned by the Town of Plympton-Wyoming.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 2

February 25, 2015

Suncor Energy Products Inc. (Suncor) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the OEB) on September 12, 2014, under subsection 41(9) of the *Electricity Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule A, as amended (the Electricity Act) for an order or orders of the OEB establishing the location of Suncor's proposed distribution facilities within certain road allowances owned by the Town of Plympton-Wyoming (the Town).

Suncor requested a written hearing while the Town requested an oral one. The OEB has decided to hold an oral hearing. The scope of the hearing is limited to hearing evidence and argument on the proposed location of the distribution facilities within the Town's road allowances and the reasons why the proposed location is appropriate. The OEB's expectation is that the Town will provide a technical expert as a witness at the hearing. Suncor may also provide a technical expert as a witness if it so desires.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

THE OEB ORDERS THAT:

1. An oral hearing will be held on **March 20, 2015** at the OEB offices at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th floor at 9:30 am.

All filings to the OEB must quote file number EB-2014-0295, be made through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties shall use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca.

If the web portal is not available, parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
