Re: Application to

- **Amend the licence of the Independent Electricity System Operator (“IESO”), EB-2013-0066 and**
- **Cancel the licence of the Ontario Power Authority (“OPA”), EO-2010-0220**

The IESO is seeking to amend the IESO’s licence and cancel the licence of the OPA. The IESO requests that the proceeding be disposed of without a hearing as allowed by section 21(4)(b) of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*.

The request to amend the IESO licence and cancel the OPA licence results from the revisions made to the *Electricity Act* which came into effect January 1, 2015 and which amalgamated the two entities.

Attached to this application is a draft amended licence. The amendments sought incorporate those sections from the OPA licence which were not in the IESO licence or were more clearly written than in the IESO licence. Also included is an addition to the licence which is required by the Minister’s March 24, 2014 Directive to the OEB in relation to CDM. The IESO has not made nor is it seeking to add or remove any new wording or sections beyond those discussed above.
