Phase 2 of Hydro One Networks Inc.'s Leave to Construct Supply to Essex County
Transmission Reinforcement Project

On January 28, 2015, the Ontario Energy Board (the “Board”) issued its Notice of New Cost Allocation Issue and Procedural Order No. 3 (the “Notice”) with respect to the above-mentioned proceeding. In the Notice, the Board asked that interested parties apply for intervenor status in Phase 2 of this proceeding by March 4, 2015.

The Board has advised that Phase 2 of this proceeding will deal with the appropriate allocation of costs associated with transmission connection assets between system benefit and customer benefit and that the findings could inform policy related changes to the cost responsibility rules in the Transmission System Code and Distribution System Code.

As an electricity distributor, Oakville Hydro has an interest in the policies related to the allocation of costs associated with transmission connection assets. Therefore, Oakville Hydro Electricity Distribution Inc. (“Oakville Hydro”) hereby requests intervenor status in Phase 2 of this proceeding. Oakville Hydro will not seek cost awards in this proceeding.
