In accordance with:

1) subsection 41(7) of the *Electricity Act*; and

2) the OEB decision, issued on April 16, 2015, in Case Number EB-2014-0295;

Suncor Energy Products Inc. ("**Suncor**") hereby provides the Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming ("**Town**") with notice that Suncor will enter streets and highways owned by the Town on or after **Monday, May 4, 2015**, to install portions of the Distribution System for the Cedar Point II Wind Energy Project. The portions of the Distribution System will be installed in streets and highways owned by the Town in the locations set out in the Plan and Profile Drawings filed as further evidence by Suncor on March 19, 2015, Exhibit B, Tab 1, in OEB case number EB-2014-0295, unless unforeseen constraints are encountered, in which case, the locations shall be as far from the travelled portion of the road as possible while still meeting the requirements of the Ontario Electrical Safety Code and all applicable engineering, environmental and health and safety standards.

Should the Town have any objection to Suncor's stated intention, please respond to the writer as soon as possible and no later than April 30, 2015.
