We are writing on behalf of Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters ("CME").

By letter dated April 7, 2015, CME supported the relief sought in the motion filed by the Ontario Greenhouse Vegetable Growers ("OGVG") on April 4, 2015. We also agreed that a Technical Conference was needed to enable intervenors and their advisers to evaluate whether, with better consultation and cooperation between Union, Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("EGD"), and TransCanada PipeLines Limited ("TCPL"), the use of existing infrastructure could provide a more cost-effective alternative to the construction of the proposed pipeline.

On April 14, 2015 Union provided updated interrogatory responses.

Earlier today, we also benefited from the Further Written Submissions by The Association of Power Producers of Ontario ("APPrO"). We support APPrO's submissions with respect to the inadequacy of Exhibit B.APPrO.2.

Moreover, in our submission the revised interrogatory responses do not eliminate the need for a Technical Conference. A Technical Conference would provide necessary clarity to the Application through the review of the responses submitted by Union and matters connected to these interrogatories. For this reason, we urge the Board to schedule a one-day Technical Conference so that the interested parties and the Board can properly assess whether existing infrastructure could offer a more cost effective alternative to the proposed project.
