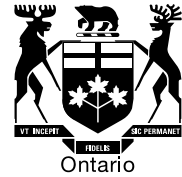

**Re: Suncor Energy Products Inc. (Suncor)
Application to Determine the Location of Distribution Facilities within Road
Allowances - Board File No. EB-2014-0355**

On April 30, 2015, the County of Lambton (County) filed a letter with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) requesting that the OEB “defer from making any ruling until after a Council County meeting scheduled for June 3, 2015”. The County noted that on April 29, 2015 it had come to terms with Suncor on the potential Road Use Agreement, and further suggested that “any deal reached between parties is a better basis for future cooperation, collaboration and interaction, than is an imposed decision from a third party”. The County stated that it is still “working towards a potentially binding deal that would address the outstanding issues, including infrastructure location”.

The County further stated that it will inform the OEB and Suncor of the outcome of County Council deliberation no later than June 4, 2015.

The OEB has considered the County’s request and invites Suncor to file a response to the specific request. Suncor shall file its response on or before May 7, 2015. In the interim the OEB suspends the dates for the filing of submissions and reply submissions set out in Procedural Order No. 2.
