Re: 2015 IRM Rate Application EB-2014-0069 Amendment to Tariff of Rates and Charges

Request

EnWin seeks an amended 2015 Tariff of Rates and Charges to address a typographical error.

For the General Service 50 to 4,999 kW Service Classification, the tariff reads:

"Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment Account (2015) – effective <u>August 1, 2015</u> until April 30, 2016 Applicable only for non-RPP customers, excluding Wholesale Market Participants" (emphasis added)

For the General Service 50 to 4,999 kW Service Classification, the tariff should read:

"Rate Rider for Disposition of Global Adjustment Account (2015) – effective <u>May 1, 2015</u> until April 30, 2016 Applicable only for non-RPP customers, excluding Wholesale Market Participants" (emphasis added)

EnWin requests this amendment on an expedited basis in order to allow EnWin to begin charging the rate rider with the first batch of bills with usage on or after May 1, 2015.

Detail

In EnWin's application in this proceeding, EnWin requested rate riders to dispose of the balance in Account 1589 – Global Adjustment over a period of 9 months: August 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016.

On February 19, 2015, the OEB issued its draft Decision and Rate Order. As discussed in the cover letter to that draft document and in the draft Decision and Rate Order itself,

the OEB noted that it would set the rate riders to dispose of the balance in Account 1589 – Global Adjustment over a period of 12 months: May 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016.

At the same time, the OEB instructed EnWin to review a Draft Rate Order and at the same time recalculate certain disposition amounts and rate riders.

On February 27, 2015, EnWin filed those revised calculations. Those calculations included the appropriate 12 month rate riders for all rate classes (as applicable) in relation to Account 1589 – Global Adjustment.

On March 19, 2015, the OEB issued a Decision and Rate Order and an accompanying Tariff of Rates and Charges. Yesterday afternoon it came to EnWin's attention that the Tariff provided Account 1589 – Global Adjustment rate riders for usage as of May 1, 2015 for all rate classes except General Service 50 to 4,999 kW. The General Service 50 to 4,999 kW rate class continues to show the rate rider coming into effect on August 1, 2015.

EnWin has done a thorough review and confirmed that the Account 1589 – Global Adjustment rate rider for General Service 50 to 4,999 kW should be effective from May 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016, in accordance with the OEB Decision. EnWin has also confirmed that the rate rider amount in the tariff of \$1.41/kW is correct and is calculated on the basis of a 12 month disposition period.

EnWin regrets that this typographical error was not caught sooner and apologizes for the inconvenience associated with addressing this issue on an expedited basis. EnWin appreciates that the onus is on the applicant to ensure the correctness of the tariff.
