<u>Undertaking</u>

To provide a breakdown of the \$8.7M 2008 Regulatory Affairs Consultants and Purchased Services Budget, by specific consultant and purchased service.

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<u>Response</u>

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The \$8.7M Consultants and Purchased Services budget for Regulatory Affairs approved for 2008 consists of \$7.7M relatd to OPG's application for payment amounts and \$1.0M for work that is not associated with the application for payment amounts. Of the \$8.7M total, \$8.4M is allocated to the regulated facilities.

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Of the \$7.7M related to the application for payment amounts, \$1.3 million is for
consultants and \$6.4M is for non-consultant related purchased services (i.e. OEB fees,
OEB cost awards and temporary hearing office). A breakdown of the \$7.7M budget is
provided in Undertaking J8.13.

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The following is a list of consultants engaged for work related to the application for payment amounts and the amounts spent to the end of May 2008. A breakdown of the budgeted amount by consultant for 2008 is not available, as the budget was prepared based on an expectation of total overall requirements.
