OPUCN Responses to Interrogatories.

Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 2 herein, we are pleased to provide OPUCN's responses to interrogatories received. OPUCN appreciates the Board's adjustment of the schedule for this filing, and the indulgence of the other parties to OPUCN's earlier request for that adjustment.

As noted in previous recent correspondence, OPUCN has responded to in excess of 1000 questions, submitted in more than 300 generally multi-part. With a smaller staff than the larger distributors have available to process this sort of task, OPUCN has done its best to answer all questions asked in as full and transparent a manner as it could within the time available. OPUCN would certainly be willing to provide any elaboration or further explanation on these responses should the Board determine that a technical conference would assist.

A number of the interrogatories requested updates to various data sets for 2014 actuals. As noted in a number of OPUCN's responses, OPUCN will file a 2014 update exhibit early next week which will address those requests not fully addressed in the responses filed herewith. This approach will be more efficient, and less redundant, than addressing each such question individually.
