**Re: Pembina Infrastructure and Logistics LP ("Pembina")
Aamjiwnaang First Nation Meeting with Pembina
Board File No.: EB-2015-0032**

In the Aamjiwnaang First Nation's ("AFN") Intervenor Request dated April 10, 2015, the AFN Environmental Department invited Pembina to attend an Environment Committee ("EC") Meeting to discuss, among other things, Pembina's Application in greater detail.

Pembina wishes to provide the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB") and other Intervenor's an update on the status of the AFN's request and Pembina's efforts to engage and consult with the AFN to date. Representatives from Pembina attended an EC Meeting with the AFN on May 5, 2015. During this meeting, Pembina discussed the Application in great detail, including outlining the EC's request to understand the caverns and in particular, their concerns that the caverns could extend into their lands. Pembina advised the EC that the Application is within Pembina's surface lease boundaries and does not extend into AFN lands. Pembina also stated that the Application details the importance of protecting the natural gas reef as critical infrastructure.

Pembina also discussed with AFN its dedicated history of stakeholder and First Nations engagement regarding its Corunna Facility, including the following engagement activities:

- October 28, 2014 – Pembina Open House
Pembina hand delivered personal invitations to attend the open house to AFN Chief and Council and a separate letter to all AFN staff and committees.
- October 31, 2014 – A Pembina representative spoke with the AFN Chief regarding setting up a meeting with the EC.
- November 18, 2014 – BluEarth and Pembina met with the EC to go over proposed solar and current expansion plans.



- November 19, 2014 – Pembina sent Species at Risk ("**SAR Report**") report to Christine Rogers at AFN.
- December 1, 2014 – Pembina met with Band Council and Chief Plain at AFN.
- January 9, 2015 – Pembina hand delivered a Project Specific Information Package to AFN regarding the Application.
- March 13, 2015 - Pembina hand delivered a letter to AFN regarding the Application.
- March 13, 2015 – Pembina delivered, by registered mail, a copy of the completed Notice, the location map, Project Specific Information Package and an electronic copy of Pembina's Application and evidence to AFN regarding the Application.
- April 13, 2015 – Pembina received an e-mail from AFN requesting a meeting to discuss Pembina's Application.
- April 14, 2015 – Pembina contacted AFN to get further details on the meeting request.
- May 5, 2015 – Pembina met with EC to review the Application. Pembina provided additional copies of material requested at the meeting for AFN's review.

Pembina is committed to maintaining the positive relationship it has with its First Nations neighbours through direct engagement and open and transparent communication. As part of our ongoing commitment to stakeholder and First Nations engagement, Pembina will follow-up with AFN and others to ensure requests and/ or concerns are addressed and mitigated where appropriate in the coming weeks.
