**Re: Union Gas Limited ("Union") – Burlington Oakville Pipeline Project
EB-2014-0182**

We are legal counsel to Union. This letter is further to the correspondence dated May 8, 2015 filed with the Board by Ontario Greenhouse Vegetable Growers ("OGVG") wherein OGVG requested a technical conference with TransCanada in attendance and subject to examination. In its correspondence OGVG asserted that Union does not oppose this request.

This assertion is incorrect. At no time has Union indicated that TransCanada should be made available for examination. Although Union has fully answered the Interrogatories that are the subject of the motion, Union indicated in its April 30 submissions that it supports a technical conference "in which *Union's witnesses* could provide further clarification of Union's evidence and interrogatory responses." At no time was TransCanada's presence suggested or accepted by Union.

The application before the Board is Union's and it bears the onus of establishing the public interest in respect of the proposed project. Union is best positioned to provide responses and clarifications required about its project and the alternatives available to it. As such, TransCanada's presence is not required.
