Union Gas Limited

Application for disposition and recovery of certain 2014 deferral account balances and approval of earnings sharing amount with ratepayers.

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1 May 27, 2015

Union Gas Limited (Union) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on April 15, 2015 for approval to dispose of and recover certain 2014 deferral account balances. The application also seeks approval to share earnings with ratepayers according to the framework in the Incentive Regulation Mechanism approved by the OEB in EB-2013-0202.

A Notice was issued on April 29, 2015 and was served and posted as per the direction of the OEB.

The following parties applied for intervenor status:

Each of APPrO, BOMA, CME, CCC, Energy Probe, FRPO, LPMA, OGVG, SEC, UGSWO and VECC also applied for cost award eligibility. No objections were received regarding the requests for intervenor status or cost eligibility.

I hereby grant intervenor status to each of the parties listed above and find that each of APPrO, BOMA, CME, CCC, Energy Probe, FRPO, LPMA, OGVG, SEC, UGSWO and VECC is eligible to apply for an award of costs under the OEB's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. The list of intervenors in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this procedural order.

The purpose of this procedural order is to set out the schedule for this hearing.

I consider it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- OEB staff and intervenors that require information and material from Union that is in addition to Union's evidence and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to Union and the intervenors by June 8, 2015.
- 2. Union shall file with the OEB complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors by **June 26, 2015**.
- 3. Unless otherwise ordered by the Board, a Settlement Conference will be convened on **July 8**, **9 and 10**, **2015** at 9:30 a.m. with the objective of reaching a settlement among the parties on the issues. The Settlement Conference will be held in the Board's hearing room at 2300 Yonge Street, 25th Floor, Toronto.
- 4. Any Settlement Proposal arising from the Settlement Conference shall be filed with the Board no later than **July 24, 2015**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, EB-2015-0010 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format,

along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
