Further to our correspondence of May 13th concerning the schedule for this proceeding, we can provide additional information pertaining on the matter. Our experts have now reviewed the filings and submitted interrogatories and have confirmed that the company filings lack significant detail that is required to analyse the proposals. GEC's interrogatories to Enbridge number 60, but amount to approximately 222 requests including the subparts of queries. GEC has asked Union 60 IRs amounting to approximately 176 requests including subparts. Accordingly, it is quite clear that it will take a considerable effort to digest the responses and compose our evidence.

Compounding our concern is the challenge facing one of our witnesses who has a previous commitment for the week of June 28th and has now learned that he is scheduled for presurgery medical appointments on July 6th. That would leave him only 3 to 4 working days after receipt of IRRs before these commitments preclude further effort.

Accordingly, we reiterate our request to the Board to consider extending the period for the filing of intervenor evidence following the response of the utilities to interrogatories and preferably, following responses to questions at the technical conference.
