She has worked very hard to reduce her heating and air conditioning use to keep her monthly bill as low as possible. However in the last two months the electricity charge, what she can control, has been less than 50% of her bill. The delivery charge, regulatory charge, debt retirement charge and HST account for more than half the bill. The rate increases that Hydro Ottawa is seeking seem to disproportionately impact citizens trying to conserve electricity and those on low income.
