Ontario Power Generation

Application to dispose of balances in certain deferral and variance accounts

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 7 June 10, 2015

Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on December 18, 2014 under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act,* 1998, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for an order or orders related to deferral and variance accounts, including disposition of account balances as at December 31, 2014.

Procedural Order No. 1 made provision for a settlement conference starting on May 4, 2015 and for the filing on May 22, 2015 of any settlement proposal arising from the settlement conference. On two occasions the parties requested a revised filing date for any settlement proposal arising from settlement discussions. The OEB approved an extension to May 27, 2015 and more recently to June 5, 2015.

On June 8, 2015, OPG filed correspondence advising the OEB that discussions between the parties were continuing. The parties propose a filing date of June 16, 2015 for the filing of any settlement proposal arising from settlement discussions. The OEB approves the new filing date.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Any settlement proposal arising from settlement discussions shall be filed with the OEB by **June 16, 2015**.

All filings to the OEB must quote the file number, **EB-2014-0370**, be made in searchable / unrestricted PDF format electronically through the OEB's web portal at www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/. Two paper copies must also be filed at the OEB's address provided below. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.

All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
