Pembina Infrastructure and Logistics LP

Application for Expansion of Corunna Facility within 1.6 km of the Dow Moore Storage Pool

PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 3 July 6, 2015

On January 22, 2015 Pembina Infrastructure and Logistics LP (Pembina) applied to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (MNRF) pursuant to section 11(2) of the *Oil, Gas and Salt Resources Act* (OSGRA) for approval to expand the storage capacity of natural gas liquids salt caverns storage facility in St. Clair Township in the County of Lambton (Corunna Facility). The Corunna Facility is located within 1.6 km of Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc.'s Dow Moore Designated Storage Area. As required by section 11(2) of the OSGRA the MNRF referred this application to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) for approval.

On June 12, 2015 Pembina, by way of a letter, asked the OEB to revise the procedural schedule to allow Pembina until July 27, 2015 to file additional evidence in support of its application. Specifically, Pembina stated that it has been diligently working towards obtaining a Risk Assessment that will fully address all of the components of s. 7.1 and 7.2 of CSA Z341. In this regard, Pembina has requested that Stantec Consulting Ltd. conduct modeling to assess the consequences and incremental risk associated with proposed additional hydrocarbon storage at the facility. Further, Pembina stated that it is in the process of obtaining a qualified opinion as to the current adequacy of the geomechanical assessment.

The OEB considers it necessary to make provision for the following matters related to this proceeding. The OEB may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Pembina shall file with the OEB any additional evidence, including a Risk
- 2. Assessment and Geomechanical Assessment and deliver a copy to the intervenors by **July 27, 2015**.
- OEB staff and intervenors that require information and material from Pembina that is in addition to Pembina's additional evidence filed July 27, 2015 and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to Pembina and the intervenors by August 5, 2015.
- 4. Pembina shall file with the OEB complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver a copy to the intervenors by **August 12, 2015**.
- 5. Intervenors that wish to present evidence shall file that evidence with the OEB and deliver it to Pembina and all other parties by **August 19, 2015**.
- 6. Anyone that requires information and material related to any intervenor evidence, that is in addition to the evidence filed and is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the OEB and delivered to Pembina and all other parties by **August 26, 2015**.
- 7. Responses to the interrogatories on the intervenor evidence shall be filed with the OEB and delivered to Pembina all other parties by **September 2, 2015**.
- Unless the OEB orders otherwise, intervenors and OEB staff may file any written submission with the Board and copy Pembina by September 10, 2015.
- 9. Unless the OEB orders otherwise, Pembina may file a written reply submission with the OEB by **September 17, 2015**.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2015-0032 and be made electronically in searchable / unrestricted PDF format through the OEB's web portal at <u>https://www.pes.ontarioenergyboard.ca/eservice/</u>. Two paper copies must also be filed. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.
