- 2. Once the the requirements of paragraph 1 are completed, to immediately and prior to completing any other steps required in this letter of direction, file with the OEB a pdf version of the complete (dated) Notice (Dated Notice).
- 3. No later than the date the Notice is posted on Tribute's website in accordance with paragraph 4, to serve a copy of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence, directly on the appropriate and relevant contact persons at the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation and on the Clerks of each of the Corporation of the County of Norfolk, the Corporation of the Municipality of Bayham, and the Corporation of the Municipality of Malahide.
- 4. To make a copy of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Tribute's office and in a prominent place on Tribute's website.
- 5. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 3 through 4 above immediately thereafter.
- 6. To provide a copy of the Dated Notice, the application and the evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.
