The Application requests pre-approval of the cost consequences associated with all facilities associated with the development of the proposed 2017 Dawn Parkway Project. The project and associated rate impacts have effect on the members of the FRPO.

FRPO is Ontario's leading advocate for quality rental housing, representing over 800 private owners and managers who supply over 350,000 rental suites across the province. Our members strongly believe that the rental-housing sector is best served by a competitive marketplace that offers choice and affordability in the provision of energy services. As a not-for-profit organization, FRPO does not have other funding sources to ensure experienced representation to participate in and assist the Board with regulatory proceedings. FRPO has previously assisted the Board in other matters and has been awarded costs by the Board. Therefore FRPO would respectfully request a determination of eligibility for cost award in this proceeding.

ISSUES & INVOLVEMENT

The Application is being advanced at a time of significant flux in the Ontario market and the surrounding North American market. We understand that the proposed application would facilitate additional volumes of gas sourced from Dawn to flow to Parkway and to customers downstream of Parkway. As the Board would be aware, we have advanced concerns regarding the risk of over-build of the Dawn Parkway system, its impact on the Ontario market and on long-term rates for all customers in Ontario. We are also concerned with inter-dependence of other applications such as EB-2014-0182 and EB-2015-0166.

As such, FRPO respectfully requests involvement in all facets of this proceeding. FRPO will collaborate with intervenors of similar interest and act in a responsible manner consistent the Board's Practice Directions.
