Request for Confidentiality

The OEB is in receipt of your letter dated June 27, 2015 requesting that the Geochemical Assessments (Assessments) filed be treated as confidential. You state in your letter that Pembina has obtained the written permission of a third party that the Assessments would be filed on a confidential basis and you reference Rule 10 of the OEB's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Please note that this in itself is not sufficient to comply with the OEB's Practice Direction on Confidential Filings.

Section 5.1.4 of the Practice Direction states the following:

A request for confidentiality must include the following items:

(a) a cover letter indicating the reasons for the confidentiality request, including the reasons why the information at issue is considered confidential and the reasons why public disclosure of that information would be detrimental;

Some factors that the OEB may consider in addressing confidentiality of filings made with the OEB are set out in Appendix A to the Practice Direction. We ask that you provide additional information to support your claim for confidentiality in order for the OEB to make a decision on your request.
