  - d. the Métis Nations of Ontario, Lands, Resources and Consultation Office, 75 Sherbourne St., Suite 222, Toronto, Ontario M5A 2P9
  - e. all affected utilities and railway companies
  - f. members of the Ontario Pipeline Coordinating Committee
- 3. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Enbridge's office and in a prominent place on Enbridge's website.
- 4. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 above, immediately thereafter.
- 5. To provide a copy of the Notice, application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
