

The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) has now issued its Notice of Hearing regarding Union's application for a Franchise Agreement and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity with the Municipality of Grey Highlands (Notice). 2. To make a copy of the Notice, the application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, available for public review at Union's office and in a prominent place on Union's website.
3. To file with the OEB an affidavit in both electronic and paper forms proving completion of the matters in paragraphs 1 and 2 above immediately thereafter.
4. To provide a copy of the Notice, application and evidence, and any amendments thereto, to anyone requesting the material.

You are further directed not to include any documents or materials when serving the Notice other than documents or materials expressly required by this letter of direction to be served.
