This is OPG's reply to a telephone request from Mr. Daniel Kim, Board Staff, regarding information required to complete the record in OPG's application for an order or orders granting leave to construct a 115 kV transmission line for Peter Sutherland Senior Generating Station (formerly New Post Creek Generating Station).

OPG was asked to provide a copy of the form of agreement to be used by OPG for the required easement agreement(s), per Exhibit F of the Ontario Energy Board Filing Requirements for Transmission and Distribution Applications.

As stated in OPG's application, the Proposed Line is located entirely on Crown Land owned by the Province (Ex. F1-1, page 1, lines 27, 28). As such, the form of agreement for the easement will be the form used by the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry at that time and not an OPG form. This requirement is consistent with OPG's experience with all easements negotiated with the Crown.

Based on standard practice, application for the easement and registration of the transmission line on title will be made by OPG after the Proposed Line is constructed and operational.
