Re: Union Gas Limited ("Union") Application – 2017 Dawn Parkway Project Board File No.: EB-2015-0200

The Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") is writing to request late intervenor status in the Union Gas Limited application for pre-approval of the recovery of the cost consequences associated with the installation of three new compressors along Union's Dawn to Parkway pipeline transmission system.

The IESO understands that Procedural Order No. 2 has been issued as of August 17, 2015 and does not expect its intervention will affect the existing timetable of this proceeding.

The IESO's interest in this proceeding is because it administers natural gas-fired generation contracts across Ontario. The IESO has both direct and indirect exposure to changes in gas costs, and thus has an interest in any potential rate changes in Union's service territory.
