The Ontario Energy Board (OEB) will hold a public hearing to consider the application filed by Union Gas.

The OEB is an independent and impartial public agency. We make decisions that serve the public interest. Our goal is to promote a financially viable and efficient energy sector that provides you with reliable energy services at a reasonable cost.

BE INFORMED AND HAVE YOUR SAY

You have the right to information regarding this application and to be involved in the process.

- You can review the application filed by Union Gas on the OEB's website now
- You can file a letter with your comments, which will be considered during the hearing.
- You can become an active participant (called an intervenor). Apply by August 25, 2015 or the hearing will go ahead without you and you will not receive any her notice of the proceeding.

If you write a letter of comment, your name and the content of your letter will be out on the public record and the OEB website. However, your personal telephone number, home address: and e-mail address will be removed. If you are a business, all your information will remain public. If you apply to become an intervenor, all information will be public.

This hearing will be held under section 36 of the Cintario Energy Board Act, 1998, S.O. 1998 c.15 (Schedule B).
